During the COVID-19 pandemic a total of two (2) representatives from the American Civil Liberties Union and the First Amendment Coalition per day may enter the Metro Justice court building and attend non-confidential proceedings. A total of two (2) representatives from the American Civil Liberties Union and the First Amendment Coalition per day may also enter the Juvenile Justice Center court building and attend non-confidential proceedings.

This order is executed to comply with the Settlement and Release of All Claims Agreement, signed and executed in the *American Civil Liberties Union of Southern California, et al. v. Harber-Pickens, et al.*, Case No. 20-CV-00889, on December 11, 2020.
