Can I appear for my hearing remotely through video or telephone using Zoom?

Yes. You must be prepared to provide information for the case and hearing for which you are appearing. For video appearances please make sure you have a good internet connection. Please make sure no background noise is present before connecting with the Court, and follow the steps below.

1. Visit our website at <https://www.kern.courts.ca.gov/>
2. Look for the COVID-19 Access heading
3. From the choices listed, click the link for “[Remote Court Hearings](#)”
4. Scroll to “Metro Justice Building”
5. Click on “[Division P](#)” from the list, which will display information to connect for hearing

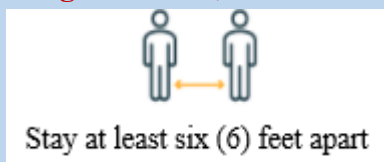
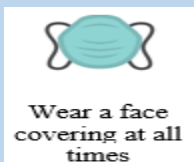
