In compliance with the California Supreme Court's decision in *Jameson v. Desta*, an in forma pauperis (fee waiver) litigant may request an official court reporter in unlimited jurisdiction civil, family law and probate proceedings notwithstanding any limitations that may be set forth in any court rule or policy to the contrary. Such request for a court reporter must be made in writing, in a separate document filed with the court at least ten (10) days before the date of the trial or hearing. The court presiding over a particular trial or hearing, for good cause, may shorten or waive the ten (10) day requirement.
