Effective Sunday, August 24, 2025, at 11:59 p.m., and until further notice the Court will no longer accept electronic filings via File & Serve. These changes are necessary for the Court's transition to a new case management system. Therefore, beginning on Monday, August 25, 2025, the Court will only accept paper filings, with the exception of probate, civil and family law, which may also utilize third party fax filing through a fax filing agency in compliance with Local Rule 1.9.

In compliance with California Rules of Court, Rule 2.210, a document will be deemed filed that day if deposited in the drop box by 4:00 p.m. on a court day. This applies to all Court authorized drop boxes located at each Kern County Superior Court location.
