THE COURT HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Except as provided in California Rules of Court, rules 2.500 through 2.507, an electronically filed document is a public document at the time it is filed. In order to ensure immediate confidentiality upon electronic filing, the filing parties/attorneys must designate documents that are required to be kept confidential by law as such by selecting "confidential" in the security field when prompted by the Court's electronic filing system. The document must also include the word "confidential" in the caption with the statutory authority, or be subject to rejection.

However, the filer cannot establish a document's security level. Rather, a document designated as "confidential" will only become confidential pursuant to legal authority or the Court's determination. Court records are presumed to be open to the

public unless confidentiality is required by law. CRC 2.550(c).

Documents that are not required to be maintained confidentially, as determined by the Court, will not be classified as such and will be available to public review regardless of how they were marked by the party/attorney at time of filing.
