
**STANDING ORDER REGARDING  
PERSONAL JUROR INFORMATION AND  
JURY LADDERS - CRIMINAL CASES**

The Judicial Courtroom Assistants, upon the direction of the Judge, are to collect from the attorneys any notes containing jurors' personal information (jury ladders, notes, etc.) and place the information into separate labeled envelopes. Any electronically held information with jurors' personal information shall be printed out by counsel, the electronic information erased, and the printouts collected by the Judicial Courtroom Assistants.

There shall be an envelope for each party which are sealed, upon court order, and designated as separate Court Exhibits in order to properly preserve the record.
